WASTEWATER OPERATOR TRAINEE

POSITION SUMMARY:

Performs wastewater treatment plant operation duties of an introductory nature. The duties in this position are designed to introduce the individual into higher level wastewater operation careers in the wastewater treatment plant. An employee initially works under direct supervision, which acquaints the trainee with the work and its relationship to other departments. After a period of orientation and on-the-job training, the employee is assigned as an operator or system maintenance person with duties becoming more difficult and supervision becoming less direct, while moving through the certification process.

CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION:

High school diploma or general education degree (GED) required and college level coursework desired; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Must pass the certification exams listed below by the required deadline:

- Alabama Grade II Wastewater certification exam as required by ADEM within a four (4) month period from the date of hire.
- Alabama Grade III Wastewater certification exam as required by ADEM within a nine (9) month period from date of hire.
- Alabama Grade IV Wastewater certification exam as required by ADEM within a twelve (12) month period from the date of hire.

Must hold a valid Alabama Driver's License and must obtain a Commercial Driver's License within 6 months of hire.

The starting pay rate at Step 0 is \$13.80 per hour, payable bi-weekly. The starting pay rate for Operator IV is \$17.30. All candidates must complete the City's employment application and submit appropriate documentation to the Human Resources Department no later than 4:30 p.m., Monday, February 20, 2012. Applications received after this time will not be considered.
